This year alone, 13 states passed legislation aimed at improving early literacy outcomes, many of which include grade retention, bringing the number of states (plus the District of Columbia) with statutory policies governing the identification of, interventions for, and/or retention of struggling readers in preschool to third grade to 32.

Often, when children enter school behind, they rarely catch up. Research indicates that children who are struggling readers in 1st grade are 88% more likely to be struggling readers in 4th grade. When children struggle to read in 4 th grade, they are four times more likely to drop out of high school.
