Quatre Bras, which means four arms, was a farm hamlet 10 miles north of Charleroi, where the road to Brussels crossed the route from Nivelles to Namur. By holding it, Ney would block Wellington's path to Blucher. "Depend on it," Ney assured Napoleon. "In two hours we shall be at Quatre Bras, unless all of the enemy's army be there!"
