A good rule of thumb is to restate your thesis statement, if you have one. Your conclusion should also refer back to your introduction, summarize three main points of your essay and wrap it all up with a final observation. If you conclude with an interesting insight, readers will be happy to have spent time on your writing.

The introduction is the first paragraph of the main body of your paper. If your instructor requires you to write an abstract, your paper will begin on the page after the abstract; otherwise, begin on the page following the title page. Use a serif typeface, such as Times New Roman, and set your word processing program to double space the lines.

How to Conclude a Thesis Paper | Synonym

Repeat your thesis statement 5 at the end of your conclusion for a research papers. In fact, both introduction and conclusion focus on the thesis. However, in the first case, the student must state it in the last word. In the closing paragraph, you begin with the thesis statement to remind your reader of what you it is about.
