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Private Duty Skilled Nursing Documentation

This document defines private duty nursing (PDN) in the home and the conditions under which it would be considered medically necessary. PDN refers to intermittent and temporary, complex skilled nursing care on an hourly basis in the home by a Registered Nurse (RN) or a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN)/Licensed Vocational Nurse (LVN).

CHAPTER 532 PRIVATE DUTY NURSING (PDN)

DEFINITIONS: Private Duty Nursing in the Home(PDN) refers to nursing, when the member requires more individual and continuous care than is available from a visiting nurse or than is routinely provided by the nursing staff of a hospital or skilled nursing facility. [1 Texas Administrative Code (TAC) § 363.303(15)].
